



Every day we see the amazing growth of Greenville County as we visit our homebound clients. While the growth has many positive effects, the challenges of rapid growth are also seen in rising food insecurity, access to healthy foods, and other vital resources needed by our residents.

REALS AND HOPE

Over the last 18 months, Meals on Wheels board members, leadership, and staff, created an ambitious five-year plan. Starting in 2022, we will build on our **#MoreThanMeals** foundation by preparing to exceed the needs of those we serve in our shared communities. As we pave the path forward, we will:

GROW WITH GREENVILLE

In order to increase the number of senior and homebound individuals we serve, we must ensure we have the capacity to meet this increase. We will address these needs by focusing on expansion and updates to our physical facilities and equipment, as well as increase our volunteer base to better serve all urban and rural areas of Greenville County — fostering additional partnerships for referral of new clients who will benefit from our services. When you drop by our office, you will see ideas already in motion with the latest addition to our vehicle fleet — our thermal controlled delivery truck that will help us reach more people with fresh nutritious meals. The wheels are already turning – stay tuned!





EXCEL IN CLIENT EXPERIENCE

Delivering high-quality, nutritious meals is the core mission at Meals on Wheels. We also want to provide more social interaction to fight the isolation and loneliness that often comes with being homebound. To help provide these experiences say hello to "Companion Charlie," our next organizational initiative which aims to connect and enhance social opportunities for clients. An initial pilot group of clients will each be given a Claris Companion tablet for one year. They'll be able to socialize with family and friends, including MOW staff, engage in exercise and brain development activities, and participate in daily at-home health and wellness assessments. As we build upon the initial launch of "Companion Charlie," our goal is to expand this program into larger groups of clients on a rotating annual schedule.

DELIVER UPON EXCELLENCE

As an organization we must strive to maintain best practices in leadership, operations, and financial stability. In 2021, our Board of Directors, led by Chairman Lucas Marchant, embraced the mission to move Meals On Wheels of Greenville into the future. As we look ahead to 2022, under the direction of Board Chairman Howie Houston, we are confident that the dedicated leadership and staff will maintain the highest standards of performance and transparency that afford us a 53-year reputation of excellence in the community.
