



At Meals on Wheels, “deliver” can mean so many things. Volunteers “deliver friendship” each weekday with a hot meal and warm smile for a homebound neighbor in need. Donors “deliver support” with each gift, no matter what the amount. Referring Partners “deliver independence” by referring individuals to Meals on Wheels so they can stay in their homes.

Meals on Wheels has embarked on a campaign to care more, serve more and do more, because there is a need in Greenville County. Nearly 10,000 elderly and disabled people right here in our community fight hunger and isolation on a daily basis. According to the US census, 14.4% of 64,977 people in Greenville County were over the age of 65 in 2010. In 2014, the number of elderly citizens grew an additional 3%, rising to 73,846. Of this number, 7,232 live in poverty and 2,728 are disabled.

Thanks to the support of generous individuals and community partners, we are able to serve 1,500 meals a day to those who suffer with physical or mental limitations. But we have the capacity to do more! With your help, we can reach out to more homebound neighbors who need a hot meal, personal visit and daily check-in. Meals on Wheels provides support for these individuals to live independently.
