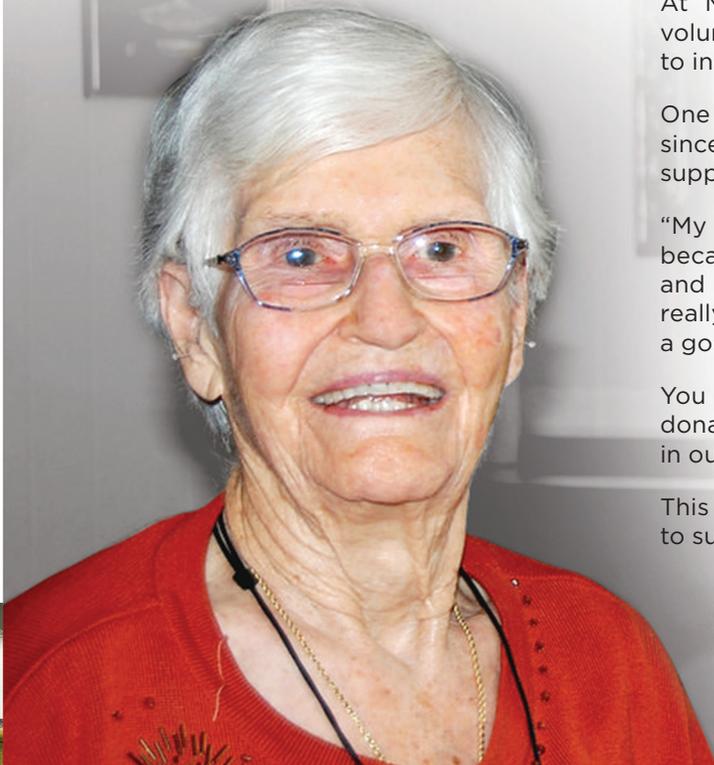
NEW YEAR, NEW MENU

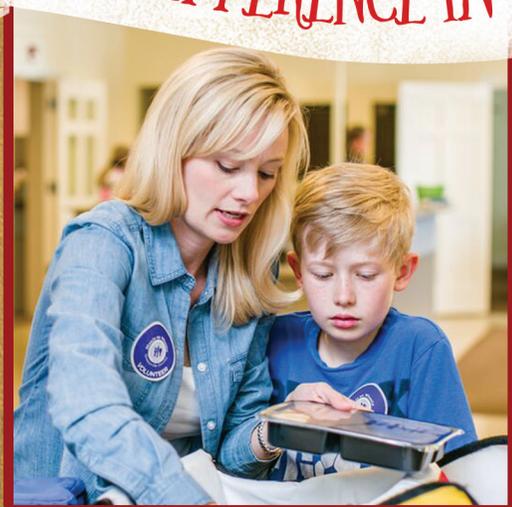
You may never get to meet Helen or the others you are helping, but your donation to Meals on Wheels delivers independence and hope right here in our community.
